

Maintenance Checklist for Standby Generators

If you have a standby generator, it will need periodic maintenance to keep it running properly and efficiently. Following are general things we can do to perform maintenance on your generator.

- Checking fluid levels
- Running unit to operating temperature
- Test battery capacity
- Perform transfer test at ATS
- Test low oil shutdown faults
- Replace oil filter
- Replace air filter
- Replace fuel filter
- Check for leaks
- Check belt tension
- Verify equipment data

Each point is not necessarily applicable to each individual system. System is evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Any necessary repairs will be billed separately.
